### **Completed Projects & Ongoing Needs**

We're thankful to report that several recent projects have been completed including the annual walkthrough of the Price House, Kendrick House, and the Manse. The Kendrick house interior has been repainted, water filtration has been added to the Manse, the balcony brass railings have been tightened and polished, and many minor repairs have been done. Your prayers and giving have made these improvements possible.

We are continuing to address a few important maintenance concerns, including obtaining reports on the condition of our buildings' roofs and the ongoing issue of discoloration on some of the ceiling tiles in the Family Life Center.
