★ Catechism for Young Children Question (for families with children *elementary and under*)

★ Scripture Memory: Psalm 46:1-6

DAILY DEVOTIONS (5 TOTAL)

Day 1

★ Reading: Romans 4:5-8

★ Questions: What are some of the blessings of forgiveness we enjoy?

What happens when we reject these blessings?

Why might we choose to reject the blessings of God?

★ End with prayer – pray for people serving in local, state, and national government.

Day 2

★ Reading: Romans 4:5-8

★ Questions: Why did Paul use David as his example here?

Why do we sometimes still feel guilty even after we know we've been for a sin?

How can we express our thankfulness for God's forgiveness?

★ End with prayer – pray for the spiritual revival of the community and nation.

Day 3

★ Reading: Romans 4:9-12

★ Questions: Why was Abraham circumcised?

If circumcision has nothing to do with our salvation, does following the law? Why/why not?

What outward signs show we have been declared righteous?

★ End with prayer – pray for the effectiveness of evangelism and discipleship.

Day 4

★ Reading: Romans 4:9-12

★ Questions: Since our outward actions don't save us? Why are we called to do them?

What is faith?

What is forgiveness?

★ End with prayer – pray for growth in love and compassion towards our neighbors.

Day 5

★ Reading: Romans 4:13-17

★ Questions: Who are Abraham's offspring?

Where in the OT does the Lord promise that Abraham would be heir of the world? How is he heir?

Why does this matter to us?

What does verse 16 tell us is necessary for salvation?

★ End with prayer – pray for personal renewal of body & spirit.
