**Catechism Question: (4/4)**

Children's Catechism

**DAILY DEVOTIONS**

**Day 1 (Sunday April 26 )**

Reading: I Chron 9 - 10

Questions:

- Summarize 9: 1 – 2
- What does the rest of Ch. 9 tell us? Why is this information important?
- What information does Ch. 10 repeat? Where was this info given initially? (I Sam 31)

Prayer for: Matt 6 – That God's kingdom come, beginning with His will being done on earth, more and more

**Day 2 - Monday**

Reading: I Chron 11

Questions:

- What did the people of Israel say in this recounting of David's being made king?
- Why did David "become greater and greater"?
- What does the rest of Ch. 11 record?

Prayer for: Matt 16:18 – For Christ to build His church, and the evil in this world not prevail against the church.

### Day 3 - Tuesday

Reading: I Chron 12

Questions:

- What does this chapter tell us about David's mighty men? (Esp. v. 1-2, 8, 18 and 22. )
- What tribes did the mighty men of David come from?
- Discuss 12:38

Prayer for: To be faithful managers of our time, talents, and treasure

### Day 4 - Wednesday

Reading: I Chron 13 - 15

Questions:

- What event does Ch. 13 again report? What stands out to you about this report?
- What did David do before going to war against the Philistines? How can we "inquire of God" today?
- What command did David give regarding the ark in Ch. 15? What reasoning did he give?

Prayer for: Rom 12: 2 – to not be conformed to this world, but that Christ's renewal of our minds change us

### Day 5 - Thursday

Reading: I Chron 16

Questions:

- What worship did David initiate once the ark was in Jerusalem?
- What stands out to you from David's song of thanks in CH. 16?

Prayer for: I Pet 4: 19 To entrust ourselves to a faithful Creator, as we do only what is good.

### Day 6 - Friday

Reading: I Chron 17 – 18

Questions:

- Why did Nathan change his advice to David in Ch. 17 ?
- What promise did God make David? How did David pray in response? (Ch. 17)
- Discuss David's victories over his enemies, and his reign over the people of Israel.

Prayer for: Ps 37:4 To delight ourselves in the Lord, and that He instruct our hearts in what we should desire.

### Day 7 - Saturday

Reading: I Chron 19 – 20

Questions:

- What did David decide about Hanun, the son of Nahash? How did the Hanun and the princes of the Ammonites respond?
- List David's other conflicts and successes.

Prayer for: For the church planting movement here, and in Mexico.
