### **Adoration**

\*THE CALL TO WORSHIP (Read Responsively)

Psalm 92:1-8 ESV

Leader: 'It is good to praise the LORD and make music to your name, O Most High,

People: To proclaim your love in the morning and your faithfulness at night, to the music of the ten-stringed lyre and the melody of the harp.

Leader: For you make me glad by your deeds, O LORD; I sing for joy at the works of your hands.

People: How great are your works, O LORD, how profound your thoughts!

Leader: The senseless man does not know, fools do not understand,

People: That though the wicked sprint up like grass and all evildoers flourish, they will be forever destroyed.

ALL: But you, O LORD, are exalted forever.

To God be the glory, great things he has done! So loved he the world that he gave us his Son, who yielded his life an atonement for sin, and opened the life-gate that we may go in.

#### Refrain:

Praise the Lord, praise the Lord, let the earth hear his voice! Praise the Lord, praise the Lord, let the people rejoice! O come to the Father thro' Jesus the Son, and give him the glory, great things he has done!

O perfect redemption, the purchase of blood! To ev'ry believer the promise of God; the vilest offender who truly believes, that moment from Jesus forgiveness receives. (*Refrain*)

Great things he has taught us, great things he has done, and great our rejoicing through Jesus the Son; but purer and higher and greater will be our wonder, our transport, when Jesus we see. (*Refrain*)

## \*The Invocation and the Lord's Prayer

Our Father who art in Heaven, hallowed be Thy name. Thy kingdom come, thy will be done on earth as it is in Heaven. Give us this day our daily bread, and forgive us our debts as we forgive our debtors. And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil, for Thine is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever. Amen.

14 And it shall be said, "Build up, build up, prepare the way, remove every obstruction from my people's way."

15 For thus says the One who is high and lifted up, who inhabits eternity, whose name is Holy: "I dwell in the high and holy place, and also with him who is of a contrite and lowly spirit, to revive the spirit of the lowly, and to revive the heart of the contrite.

16 For I will not contend forever, nor will I always be angry; for the spirit would grow faint before me, and the breath of life that I made.

17 Because of the iniquity of his unjust gain I was angry, I struck him; I hid my face and was angry, but he went on backsliding in the way of his own heart.

18 I have seen his ways, but I will heal him; I will lead him and restore comfort to him and his mourners,

19 creating the fruit of the lips. Peace, peace, to the far and to the near," says the LORD, "and I will heal him.

20 But the wicked are like the tossing sea; for it cannot be quiet, and its waters toss up mire and dirt.

21 There is no peace," says my God, "for the wicked."

But I have this against you, that you have abandoned the love you had at first. Remember therefore from where you have fallen; repent, and do the works you did at first. If not, I will come to you and remove your lampstand from its place, unless you repent. Trusting ourselves to the grace of God, let us confess our sin before God and one another.

### The Corporate Confession of Sin

Almighty God, Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, Maker of all things, Judge of all people: Our lips are ready to confess, but our hearts are slow to feel, and our wills are reluctant to repent.

We bring our entire selves to You, this morning – bend us, wound us, and, if necessary, break us. We have seen the purity of Your perfect word, the happiness of those in whose heart it reigns, the calm dignity of the walk to which it calls – yet we daily violate its precepts.

Your loving Spirit strives within us, brings us Scripture warnings, speaks in startling providences, allures by secret whispers – yet we make shameful choices that grieve Him and quench His influence. We mourn and lament these sins, crying to You for pardon.

Grant that through the tears of repentance we may see more clearly the goodness and glory of our Savior and His cross. Amen.
